Connections exist as our primary connecting point with leaders within the Network. Within our connections Pastors are proactively cared for, links to the network are maintained and developed – including connection with other arms of our ecosystem, and Connection Leaders provide personal apostolic leadership into churches – facilitating growth and strengthening them.

Providing or signposting to extra support as needed.

Our network operates over a large geographical area and we recognise that not everyone will be able to attend every in-person event.

Long Lunches serve as a roaming regional event to connect within individual geographies and aren't just for Ground Level Churches but seek to serve the local area.

"Being part of Ground Level is very much part of who we are at Springs: we have been part of the family for the 21 years of the Church's life. My memories of the network go further back: to the tender age of 15 when I first experienced a large Christian event at Grapevine. Little did I know that over 30 years later I would be leading a Fellowship not too far down the road!

Because my call to being a Pastor was a little unusual 5 years ago, I felt uneasy about the change. Fortunately, the Network's Leadership Engine was beginning its first year and I valued this support, knowledge and encouragement at the time. When leaders prayed over me at the end of the course I felt better equipped to serve and felt part of the family. That experience is repeated every time I join with the wider network of leaders, and this really does me good.

It is strange being a Pastor of a small church. You're often surrounded by your own church family in a wonderful and close-knit way. Yet at times it is a lonely role when things get tough or key decisions are to be made. That's when Ground Level support is invaluable. leadership engine

The vision for our Leadership Engine course is to see new & existing leaders equipped & released to serve God & His Kingdom:

influence

The Kingdom of God isn't exclusive to inside the 4 walls of our church buildings, and through our influence objective we're seeking to inspire people to be influential wherever God has placed them, in all spheres of life.

Through teaching, inspiration and online content we're seeking to inspire our church communities to see their work as their mission field and their Monday to Friday as their Ministry.

theology forum

Our theology forum exists to equip churches in handling theological issues. Our forum periodically meets to discuss a particular topic, which is then presented to the network through an event or resource.

Leadership Training



tuesday leaders gatherings

Each month we host a day for leaders to gather for worship, prayer, ministry, updates and to share lunch together. These days are sometimes referred to as 'Church for Church Leaders' and provide a regular meeting point where leaders can receive input and connection.

We usually invite a national speaker to join us and bring input, training and inspiration. These events are hosted in Lincoln but are also available via a zoom feed for those unable to attend in-person.

Every quarter we gather senior leaders from our connecting churches to spend a day learning and growing together. These days focus around a specific topic with plenty of opportunities for discussion and learning from each other.

National Forums are designed to be relevant and collaborative, focusing on challenges facing churches today and allowing space for us to journey to answers together in an informal setting.

leaders conference

The Ground Level Leaders Conference is our annual gathering to connect, be inspired and hear what the Holy Spirit is saying, so we can follow his lead. It is a time to renew relationships, build new ones and a time to be refreshed. It's for pastors, leaders, staff team members, key volunteers, as well as emerging and younger leaders. Our speakers will include invited guests, friends and leaders from within our network.

Through a programme of Keynotes, Discussions, Celebrations and Co Labs, which will take a dive into leadership subjects and practices, we know that this conference will be a rich time of impartation from the Holy Spirit.

A highlight of our conference is always the space that we make for friendship and connection which remains a priority for future events.

awaken

Awaken is our flagship event of the year, gathering together all of our churches for a time of celebration, Awaken is about being together, going deeper in our faith, and enjoying the gift of life.

The event will include everything there is to love about a summer gathering, with dynamic worship, inspirational teaching, encounters with the Holy Spirit and opportunities to go deeper in our faith. All alongside great kids and youth programmes, activities for the whole family and space to be together in church community. We're excited to step into all that God has for us and hope that you can join us.

coaching

Ground Level work with a team of coaches who are able to offer free introductory sessions to Network members.

Coaching is designed to engage you in a thought-provoking and creative process that inspires you to maximise your personal and professional potential. The process of coaching often unlocks previously untapped sources of imagination, productivity and leadership.

We all have goals we want to reach, challenges we're striving to overcome and times when we feel stuck. Partnering with a coach can change your life, leading you to greater personal and professional fulfilment.

wellbeing

Ground Level recognise that Leadership wellbeing is vitally important so we've teamed up with some trusted counsellors and therapists who are able to support you in this area. This team are able to offer free assessments to those in the Network, advice and direction for those dealing with mental health challenges in their congregations and training for Leaders and Teams.

"Becoming part of the Ground Level Network has been a huge blessing, both for me personally and for us as church. It really has filled a hole. It's not like things were all 'bad'. Not at all! We had much to be thankful for, it's just we felt things could be 'better'.

We had come to a place where we realised there were some things we were missing... Output levels for us (as often is the case for so many Leadership teams) were running high in our own local setting, far exceeding any input we were receiving, we felt a little isolated, even dare I say, a bit lonely. Things were out of balance. We needed some input, where we could just come and receive, and in doing so, be filled up and built up, inspired, encouraged and cheered on. We really feel we've found it now!

Within Ground Level we've found connection beyond just our own context, people who we could just chat to, enjoy being with, pick up a phone if we need to, turn to for some advice, find some support, people who may even help us to think or see things differently.


