Job Title: Marketing and Communications Officer

Department: Ground Level Office

Main Purpose of Job: To be responsible for efficient and effective communications for Ground Level both within the network and externally.

Duties Include:

- Communications support for the Operations Team
- Creating a promotional plan for each event; One event, GLX, Leadership Engine, and other Ground Level events.
- Develop and implement a social media calendar.
- Create and distribute monthly email newsletters.
- Assist the Strategy Team to develop a communications tool box for use across the organisation.
- Liaise with partner organisations to implement wider promotion opportunities.

As part of the Ground Level Operations Team you will be expected to support and maintain the values of the organisation. There may be a requirement to support the wider team which may include some day to day tasks in respect of event management and administration.
