

The Leadership Engine Training Year has run for nine years and has trained and empowered over 250 leaders. Our VISION is to see NEW & EXISTING leaders equipped & released to serve God & HIS Kingdom. The Course consist of:



- LAUNCH WEEKEND in November: all day Friday and Saturday
- TWO Saturday training days
- TWO sets of video teaching
- A second RESIDENTIAL in March: all day Friday and Saturday
- IN CHURCH MENTORING: A mentoring programme set up within your local church, ensuring every student on the full course gets the best out of the year and grows in their faith and their gifting
- HOMESTUDY ACTIVITIES: Optional extra study activities following on from the modules.

Year ONE is focused on general leadership within a church and is suitable for anyone with a leadership role or who is working towards a leadership role within a church. Year TWO is more focused on whole church leadership issues and is most suitable for anyone with a senior or whole church leadership role or is aspiring to such a role. The two courses will run on the same day & venue.

Acceptance on the course is via a short application supported by a reference from the local church. Each year costs approximately £575 per person (all accommodation, food, resources and teaching included). The final costs are to be confirmed.

YEAR ONE Overview (All Dates and Venues are to be confirmed):

MODULE 1 Launch weekend – Friday 13th & Saturday 14th November

“Leading SELF well”

- Session 1 “Theology of Leadership” *A biblical overview of the role of leadership within the church including the role of elders, deacons and the Ephesians 4 ministry gifts*
- Session 2 “Understanding Self 1” *We will look at calling in Leadership, how do we know God is calling us and what is He asking us to do.*
- Session 3: “History of Leadership” *A historical overview of the role of leadership within the church including its early development and its evolution over the centuries.*
- Session 4 “How to read the Bible” *How do we read and interpret scripture, an understanding of hermeneutics & exegesis*
- Session 5 “Understanding Self 2” *We will look at leadership styles, issues of character and integrity, our core values and how these impact how we lead others and address some of the lies of leadership”*
- Session 6 “Introducing theology” *How do we define theology, where does theology come from (scripture, tradition, reason, experience), what’s the relationship between theology and philosophy?*

Module 2 (Video teaching December) “The THEOLOGY of God”

- Session 1 “Proof of His existence” *The idea that we can prove or disprove the existence of God is a bit of a misnomer however this session will seek to give rationale for a belief in the existence of God.*
- Session 2 “Attributes of God” *What is God like? How much of God can we really know? Which attributes do we share with God and which are unique to Him?*
- Session 3 “The Trinity” *What is this key theological concept and what is the biblical background for it?*

Module 3 Saturday 23rd January: “The THEOLOGY of Jesus”

- Session 1 “The humanity and divinity of Jesus” *How can Jesus be fully God and fully man? What does that mean?*
- Session 2 “The cross and the gospel” *An understanding of the theological impact of the death of Jesus and what this means for those who respond to him and those who don’t*
- Session 3 “Resurrection and Ascension” *What does it mean to have a risen saviour, how do we “prove” this, where is Jesus now?*

Module 4 Residential – Friday 5th– Saturday 6th March 2027

- Session 1 “Leading others” *How do we lead others, getting the best out of them?*
- Session 2 “Who is the Holy Spirit” *Understanding how the Holy Spirit fits in the trinity and our lives*
- Session 3 “Leading Teams 2” *How do we give feedback and deal with difficult issues and what are some of the leadership lies we have to overcome?*
- Session 4 “Work of the Holy Spirit” *What does the Holy Spirit do for us and the church?*
- Session 5 “Gifts of the Holy Spirit” *We will explore the gifts, thinking carefully how they work in the church today*
- Session 6 “Leading in the power of the Holy Spirit” *What does it mean to lead being led by God’s Spirit?*

- Session 1 "What is the Kingdom" *A biblical overview of the Kingdom of God*
