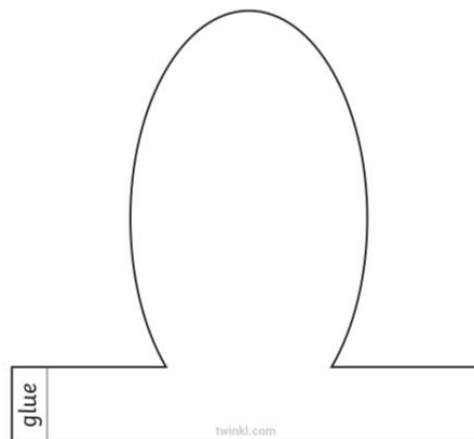
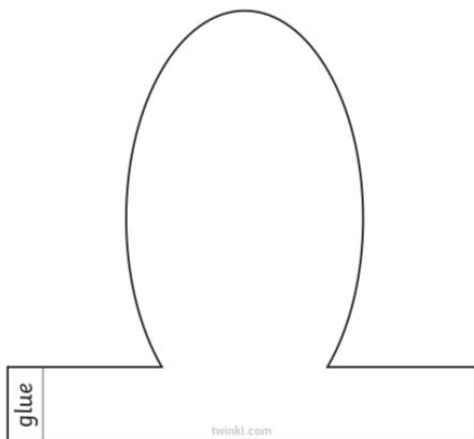
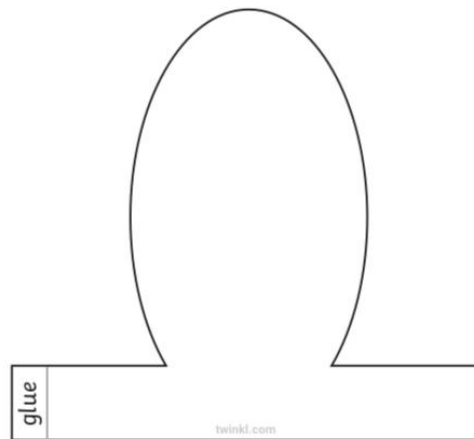
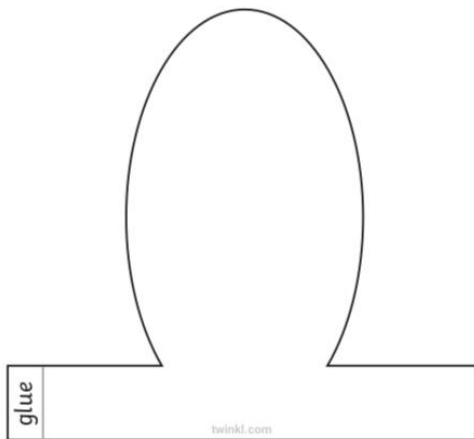
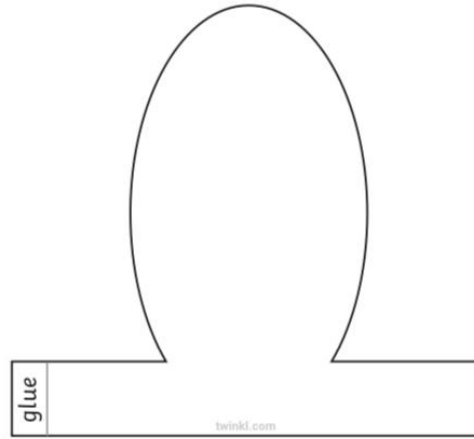
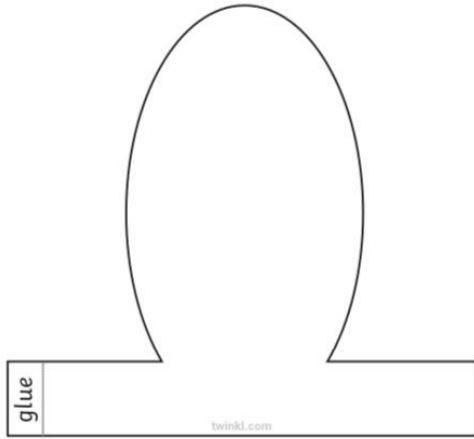
colour our skin is, whether we are young or old, we are all human. That means that everybody is equally valuable and we should treat everybody as being as important as ourselves.”
