## **Big Game: Who stole the Key?**

Sit the children in a circle and place a chair in the middle. Choose one child to sit on the chair and tell them to close their eyes.

Place a set of keys under the chair and quietly choose a child who is sitting in the circle to 'steal' the keys and hide them behind them.

Once they have the keys hidden tell the child on the chair to open their eyes. They now have to guess who the key thief is.

Once the key thief is found the keys go back under the chair. You can do as many turns as you like!

## **Big Activities**

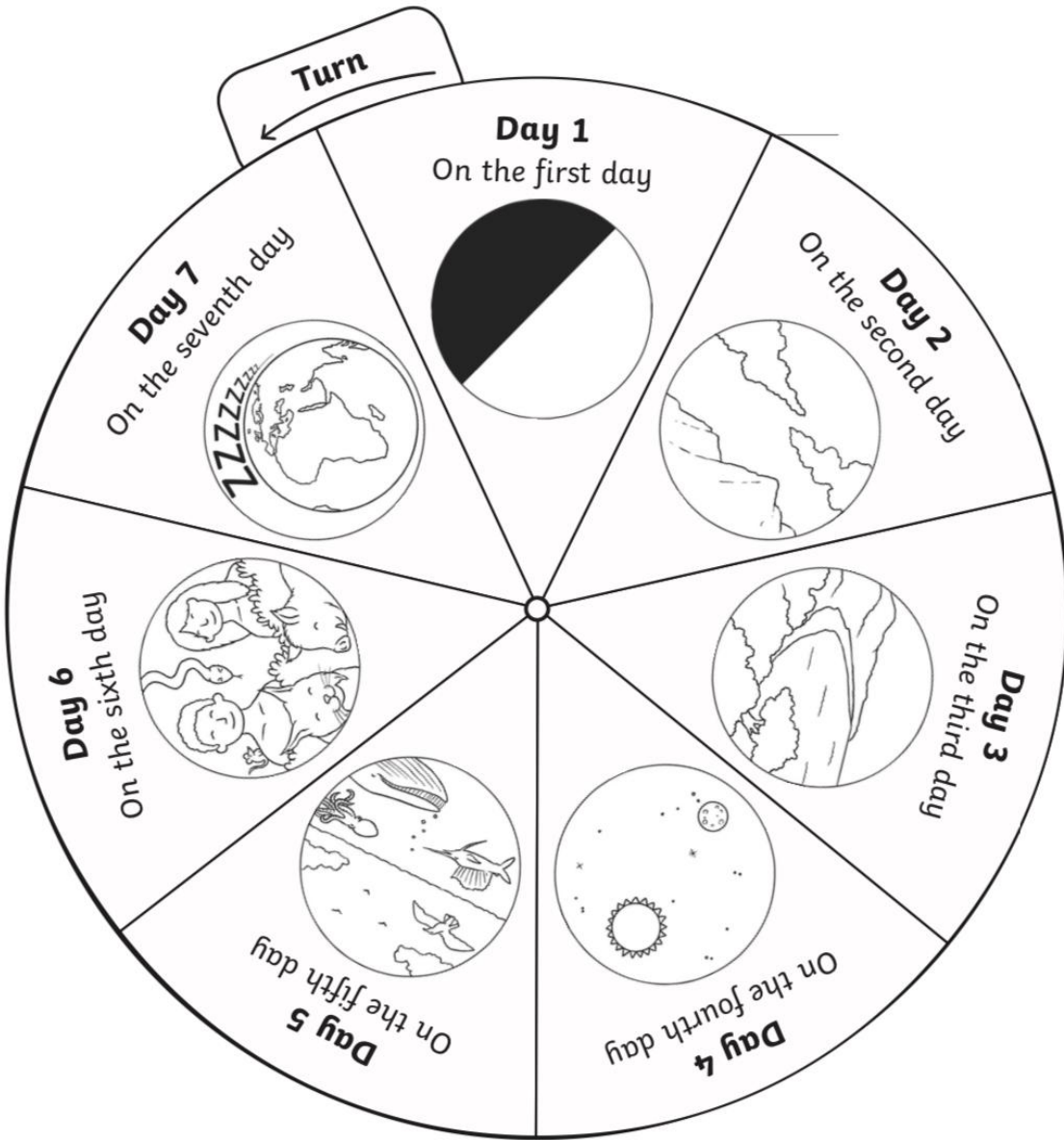
Creation posters: These can be as elaborate or simple as needed maybe consider using natural materials such as twigs/leaves/grass/sand/pebbles
